How developed	Literature was reviewed and recommendations were established by consensus within and the Endocrine Society (ES).
Additional essential patient information	 Representative home and office blood sugar measurements Evidence or history of diabetes Recent blood glucose, creatinine, and hemoglobinA_{1c} History of previous treatment, if any
Additional patient information, if available	 Clinical evidence of vascular disease, renal disease, retinopathy or neuropathy Recent complete blood count, electrolytes, blood urea nitrogen, and creatinine levels Urinalysis and urine chemistry (i.e. urine micro albumin, creatinine) Recent ophthalmological examination Electrocardiogram The patient should bring their glucometer to the consultation if they have one
Alarm symptoms/conditions	Pregnancy
